Re: COVID-19 Update

Yesterday, six team members tested positive for COVID- 19. Of the six, five work in the health care center while one team member works in residential living.

The Forsyth County Health Department and North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services have recently adopted the CDC (Centers for Disease Control and Prevention) guidelines on health care personnel returning to work. The following protocol is for all personnel regardless of vaccination status:

- Stay home for 5 days.
- If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are resolving after 5 days, you can leave your house.
- Continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.
- If you have a fever, continue to stay home until your fever resolves.
